Wind & Solar Renewable Energy Incentive Program

This program supports research and development of financially viable small-scale wind and solar renewable energy projects, less than 40 KW.

Incentive Programs

Residential

(Limit 1 per account, 38 per year maximum)

- Members receive a 50% discount for a site assessment for a small-scale renewable energy project. An assessment will be scheduled by Barron Electric with a certified assessor by the Midwest Renewable Energy Association (MREA). At the time of the assessment, members pay \$200, and Barron Electric will also pay \$200 toward the site assessment.
- A \$300 rebate is available for members purchasing a **solar water heater** with a controlled electric back up.

Business and Farm

- Members receive a 75% discount for a site assessment. The average assessment cost is \$750, the member's cost is approximately \$200.

A certified assessor will visit a home or business to analyze its renewable energy potential. Some assessors can evaluate multiple technologies during your site assessment. An assessor will give a written report that provides:

- A basic analysis of the member's energy needs.
- Recommendations for energy efficiency to help lower your energy use and reduce the size and type of the renewable energy system needed.
- An evaluation of the renewable energy resources at the site.
- Recommendations for size and type of renewable energy system to meet the member's needs.
- An estimated output of the renewable energy system, based on the resource estimate.
- Information on the best place to locate a system on your property.
- A general cost estimate for the system.
- The next steps for completing the project.

- The assessment must be scheduled through Barron Electric.
- The assessment must occur prior to 12-15-2010.
- A random inspection may be conducted to verify installations.
- Barron Electric reserves the right to deny or limit any application.
- Rebates/incentives are limited to the available funds and may be discounted before the end of the program period at the sole discretion of the cooperative.
- Program expires 12-15-2010.

Evergreen Program

Dairyland Power Cooperative's generation resources include coal, natural gas, hydro, wind, landfill gas and animal waste. Cooperative members can voluntarily support the further development of Dairyland's renewable energy program by joining the Evergreen Program. The cost is \$1.50 per block, which is in addition to member's monthly electric bill. After a one-year commitment, subscriptions can be cancelled with a thirty-day notice.
